"ALTHOUGH IT IS DIFFICULT TO QUANTIFY, THESE ECONOMIC ILLS HAVE UNDOUBTEDLY BEEN EXACERBATED SOMEWHAT BY RECENT POLITICAL PROBLEMS. EXPORT GROWTH WAS NEGATIVE IN REAL TERMS LAST YEAR AND IS WELL BELOW ITS RECENT HISTORICAL TREND THIS YEAR. INVESTMENTS HAVE FALLEN SHARPLY, AND BOTH SECTORS ARE SUBJECT TO THE PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS OF POLITICAL DISTURBANCES. BEYOND THAT, WE ASSUME THAT DISRUPTIONS HAVE OCCURRED IN THE ECONOMY BECAUSE OF DECREASED EFFICIENCY IN BOTH GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE SECTORS CAUSED BY HIGH-LEVEL PERSONNEL CHANGES AND CIVIL DISORDERS.
