7. SUMMARY: THIS REPORT TRANSMITS INFORMATION ABOUT THE EXTENSION OF MARTIAL LAW IN ROK.

BA' (U) DETAILS:

STUDENT PROTESTS TO FORCE THE ROKG TO LIFT MARTIAL LAW (ML) HAVE HAD JUST THE OPPOSITE EFFECT. 2130 HOURS, THE NIGHT OF 17 MAY 1980, THE ROKE CALLED AN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE CABINET, CHAIRED BY THE PRIME MINISTER WHICH ENDORSED THE PLAN FOR TOTAL HL. IN EFFECT HL WAS EXTENDED TO CHEJU-DO ISLAND MAKING ML EFFECTIVE IN ALL PARTS OF THE ROK. DECREE NUMBER 10 WAS UNIVERSITIES AND ENACTED AS REPORTED IN IR COLLEGES WERE CLOSED. EIGHTEEN STUDENT LEADERS WERE REPORTED ARRESTED. LABOR ACTIVIST RECEIVED STERN WARNINGS THAT STRIKES OF ANY KIND WOULD NOT BE TOLERATED. PUBLIC STATEMENTS REFLECTING ANTI-GOVERNMENT VIEWS WERE BAND. THIS LATTER EDICT WAS NO DOUBT DIRECTED AT INCREASED PRESSURE FROM THE KEY POLITICAL LEADERSHIP AGAINST THE HILITARY'S AND THE INTERIM GOVERNMENT'S POLICIES AS MUCH AS AT THE STUDENTS AND OTHER ACTIVIST ELEMENTS WITHIN THE ROK SOCIETY. THIS INSTITUTION OF TOTAL HL IS PATTERNED AFTER PRESIDENT PARK'S INITIATION OF ML IN THE EARLY 78'S TO CHOL PROTESTS, PARTICULARLY STUDENT PROTESTS AGAINST HIS YUSHIN GOVERNMENT. THEN TOTAL HE HAD THE DESIRED EFFECT. THE SITUATION WAS COOLED. NOW AS THEN THERE ARE MANY SIKILARITIES, HOWEVER THERE ARE ALSO SOME KEY DISSINILARITIES. STUDENTS NOW ARE BETTER ORGANIZED THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY: THE ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT IS AT AN EXTREME LOW WITH UNEMPLOYMENT AT HIGH LEVELS, AND PAY LAGGING WELL BEHTNO COST OF LIVING FACTORS. BOTH OF THE KEY POLITICAL PARTIES ARE VOICING STRONG CRITICISM TOWARD THE MILITARY AND THE CHOI INTERIN GOVERNMENT. TWO OF THE THREE LEADING POLITICAL CANDIDATES FOR PRESIDENT HAVE BEEN REPORTED ARRESTED IN THE WAKE OF TOTAL ML. AS TO WHY IS NOT YET CLEAR. THE PRESIDENT, (CHOI), HAS NOT YET MADE A PERSONAL STATEMENT SUPPORTING THE EXTENSION OF ML. IS TOO EARLY TO GET A CLEAR READING ON PUBLIC REACTION TO THE NEW ML EDICT. BASED ON EAPLIER CONTACTS WITH STUDENT AND FACULTY SOURCES, THE CLOSING OF THE UNIVERSITY WAS A GOAL OF THE STUDENTS IN ORDER TO FOCUS MORE ATTENTION TO

THEIR CAU. IF STUDENT PLANS HAVE NOT CHANGED, STUDENT DEMONSTRATIONS IN VIOLATION OF THE NEW DECREE MAY START BY EARLY EVENING, 18 MAY.
ALSO WITH STUDENT LEADERSHIP UNDER ARREST, THERE IS A STRONG POSSIBILITY FACULTY MEMBERS WILL OPENLY JOIN IN THE PROTESTS WITH THEIR STUDENTS.

AFTER THREE DAYS OF STREET DEMONSTRATIONS -2'-13-15 HAY, IT WAS EVIDENT THAT THE STUDENT LEADERSHIP WAS EXTREMELY DISAPPOINTED BY BLHE LACK OF PUBLIC SUPPORT FOR FOR THEIR MOVEMENT'S THE GOVERNMENT'S HODERATE STANCE HAD SUCCEEDED IN, AT A MINIMUM, HOLDING PUBLIC OPINION AT A STANDSTILL AND PROBABLY HAD GARNERED SOME MODEST ADDED SUPPORT IN FAVOR OF THE INTERIM GOVERNMENT. NOW WITH TOTAL HL, THE MILITARY COMMITTED TO KEY LOCATIONS THROUGH-OUT THE CITY AND THE BULK OF THE SF POISED TO MEET ANY PUBLIC VIOLATIONS OF DECREE NUMBER 10, THE CHANCES THAT THE NEXT RESPONSE FROM THE GOVERNMENT WILL BE MODERATE IS VERY SLIGHT. HOW THE GENERAL PUBLIC WILL REACT TO MILITARY/STUDENT CONFRONTATIONS SHOULD THEY OCCUR IS STILL ANYONE'S GUESS. AN OVER-REACTION BY THE MILITARY COULD SHING PUBLIC SENTIMENT TO THE STUDENTS. CONVERSATIONS WITH SENIOR MILITARY OFFICIALS REFLECTED A UNWAVERING CONVICTION THAT A STRONG HAND WAS NEEDED RATHER THAN THE MODERATE RESPONSE SHOWN 13-15 MAY. HOWEVER SHOULD MILITARY/STUDENT CLASHES RESULT IN BLOODSHED, HOW THIS WILL LIKELY PLACE PRESSURE ON THE CURRENT MILITARY RULING CLIQUE IS ANOTHER POINT FOR CONJECTURE. BT #628A ANNOTES
