Z: SUMMARY: THIS REPORT TRANSMITS INFORMATION ABOUT THE ARREST OF STUDENT LEADERS ON 17 MAY 1980.

DETAILS: SOURCE REPORTED THAT DURING A 84. MEETING OF STUDENT LEADERS AT EWHA UNIVERSITY IN SECUL AT WHICH LEADERS FROM ALL OVER THE COUNTRY WERE IN ATTENDANCE POLICE SUDDENLY APPEARED ON CAMPUS WITH INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE ARRESTS. INITIALLY APPROXIMATELY 200 STUDENTS (ALMOST ALL IN ATTENDANCE) WERE DETAINED AT THE ENHA CAMPUS. SUFFICIENT POLICE BUSES WERE THERE TO TRANSPORT ALL 200. TEN YOUNG WOMEN (EWHA STUDENTS) WERE AHONG THOSE DETAINED. THE PRESIDENT OF ENHA IMMEDIATELY WENT TO ROK ARMY HEAD-HE WAS NOT QUARTERS DEMANDING TO SEE THE CHIEF OF STAFF. AVAILABLE BECAUSE HE WAS ALREADY IN ATTENDANCE AT A PRE-LIMINARY HEETING WITH PH ((SHIN)) WHICH WAS FOLLOWED BY A SERIES OF MEETINGS THAT ENDED IN TOTAL ML. THE PRESIDENT OF ENHA INSTEAD MET WITH THE VICE CAS, LTG ((HUANG)) TO REQUEST THE RELEASE OF ENHA WOMEN INTO HER CUSTODY. LTG HWANG REFUSED SAYING HE COULD NOT MAKE THAT DECISION. PRESIDENT RETURNED CONTINUING HER PLEA WITH THE POLICE AT BY THIS TIME 25 STUDENTS WERE SINGLED OUT FOR THE CAMPUS. ARREST. THIS INCLUDED THE TEN WOMEN FROM ENHA. THE WOMEN AND HEN WERE LOADED ON SEPARATE BUSES AND AS THEY LEFT THE CAMPUS FOR JAIL THE POLICE STOPPED THE BUS WITH THE ENHA WOMEN OUTSIDE OF THE CAMPUS GATES AND LET THE MOMEN RETURN TO THE CAMPUS WITHOUT FURTHER HARRASSHENT. ONLY 15 MEN, MOSTLY FROM THE SECUL AREA WERE TAKEN OFF BY THE POLICE.

THE POLICE ACTION IN THIS CASE SEEMS VERY UNCLEAR, WHEN THEY HAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO ARREST 200 OF THE PRINCIPAL STUDENT LEADERS, BUT INSTEAD NARROWED IT DOWN TO 15. PERHAPS THEY FEARED UNDUE REACTION TO THE ARREST OF ALL 200, ALTHOUGH GIVEN THE PRESENT ATMOSPHERE WITHIN THE ROK I DOUBT THAT THIS WAS A CONSIDERATION. SOURCE SUGGESTED THAT IF THE GOVERNMENT (LTG ((CHON)) TU HAN) WANTED STUDENTS TO PICKUP THE "GAUNTLET" IN VIEW OF THE GOVERNMENT'S NEGATIVE RESPONSE TO STUDENT DEMANDS, THEN THEY WOULD NOT LEAVE THEN LEADERLESS. PERHAPS THIS WAS ONLY AN EXTENSION OF THE GOVERNMENT'S MODERATE HANDLING
