SUBJECT: WANTED STUDENT REPORTEDLY
- FLEES TO JAPAN, U.S.

1. (U) A KYODO DISPATCH REPORTS THAT A STUDENT WANTED BY ROK AUTHORITIES FOR HAVING SERVED AS A MALE NURSE IN A "FIELD HOSPITAL" DURING THE KWANGJU UPRISING FLED TO JAPAN ON JUNE 19 ACCOMPANIED BY A FEMALE COMPANION. ON JUNE 26, HE REPORTEDLY LEFT JAPAN FOR THE U.S. ON A FALSE PASSPORT.

2. (U) JUNICHI TOMIMURA, 30, AN "ANTIWAR ACTIVIST" IN CHIBA CITY, IS SAID TO HAVE AIDED THE PAIR (THE GIRL WAS TRANSFERRED TO A "SAFETY ZONE" BY "SYMPATHIZERS"). THE TWO TOLD TOMIMURA THAT IT WAS NOT KIM DAE JUNG (M-R: KIM TAE CHUNG) BUT RATHER THE ROK MILITARY WHICH HAD INSTIGATED THE KWANGJU UPRISING: "YOUNG WORKERS WHO STARTED THE RIOT WERE APPARENTLY SOUTH KOREAN OFFICERS."
