- 2. HUNDREDSOOF UNIFORMED AND PLAIN-CLOTHES POLICEMEN ARMED WIJHOUGHT STICKS AND WALKIE-TALKIES PATROLLED SEOUL'S EWANGHWAMUN AND DOWNTOWN AREAS THE EVENING OF NOVEMBER 28. POLICE PRESENCE WAS IN RESPONSE TO THE CALL AT LAST SATURDAY'S YWCA INCIDENT FOR DEMONSTRATIONS IN MAJOR OFFICE AGAINST THE PLANNED PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION. (ALTHOUGH THE MARTIAL LAW COMMAND (MLC) HAD ALLOWED PUBLICATION OF THE PROPOSED NOVEMBER 28 DATE.) IN ADDITION TO NUMEROUS FOOT PATROLS AT STREET CORNERS, BUILDING ENTRANCES, AND PEDESTRIAN UNDERPASSES, LARGE NUMBERS OF POLICE, CITY, TOURIST, AND COMMUTER BUSES WITH ADDITIONAL CONFIDENTIAL

POLICE WERE PARKED LESS THAN INCONSPICUOUSLY ON MANY BACK STREETS. THE POLICE BEGAN TO DEPLOY AT 1600 AND WERE ON DUTY THROUGHOUT THE EVENING. THE MOST INTIMIDATING FEATURE WAS THE POSTING OF APPROXIMATELY 20 ARMED AND HELMETED SOLDIERS ON THE STEPS OF THE SEJONG CULTURAL CENTER OVERLOOKING THE MAIN SEJONG-NO THOROUGHFARE.

3. THIS APPARENTLY WAS THE LARGEST SHOW OF POLICE FORCE IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA SINCE OCTOBER 1978, WHEN A DEMON-

STRATION WAS REPORTEDLY PLANNED FOR THE YUSIN SYSTEM'S SIXTH ANNIVERSARY. ALTHOUGH IMPRESSIVE IN ITSELF, LAST NIGHT'S POLICE ACTION WAS MUCH LESS FORMIDABLE THAN THAT IN 1978, WHEN POLICE IN FULL RIOT GEAR STOOD SHOULDER-TO-SHOULDER ALONG THE STREETS. THIS TIME AROUND, POLICE INTERFERED LESS WITH THE PASSERSBY: ALTHOUGH STUDENT-TYPES WERE ASKED TO IDENTIFY THEMSELVES AND TO OPEN THEIR BAGS AND PACKAGES FOR INSPECTION, POLICE DID NOT TAKE THE COMMON PRECAUTION OF CLOSING THE AREA BUS STOPS. CONSEQUENTLY, CROWDS IN THE KWANGHWAMUN AREA WERE AS LARGE AS NORMAL FOR THE END OF THE WORK DAY.

4. PRESUMABLY THE AUTHORITIES HAD REASON NOT TO EXPECT ANY REAL TROUBLE, SINCE SOME 160 OF THE PERSONS MOST LIKELY TO PARTICIPATE IN A DOWNTOWN DEMONSTRATION HAVE BEEN DETAINED WITHIN THE LAST WEEK. AS FAR AS WE KNOW, NO INCIDENTS TOOK PLACE LAST NIGHT ND NO ONE WAS ARRESTED. \*\* NEVERTHELESS, THE PREVENTIVE ACTION, PARTICULARLY AFTER THE PUBLICATION OF THE CALL FOR A KWANGHWAMUN DEMONSTRATION IN THE PRESS, UNDOUBTEDLY DEMONSTRATED TO A LARGE NUMBER OF SECULITES THAT THE MLC IS SERIOUS ABOUT ITS REPEATED STATEMENTS THAT IT WILL NOT TOLERATE SOCIAL DISORDER.
